April 14, 2026

The Burt City Council met in regular session at 6:05 p.m. on April 14, 2026, in the Burt City Hall Council Chambers. All council members agreed to move the May meeting to May 7th.

All council members were in favor of only allowing service and therapy animals are allowed in city buildings and must have a leash.
