If you need garbage stickers, appliance stickers, or even to fill out a dumpster request form the library can help with all of this.

The city has updated their computer software! With this, it has the ability for you to have **access to your own account!** Follow these directions to sign up! 1.) Go to: <https://burtiowa.frontdeskqworks.com/> 2.) Create new. 3.) Are you already receiving utility bills from us? **CHOOSE YES**. 4.) Then you will type in the account number and street address. Use the exact street address on your bill. By signing up for Front Desk not only will you have access to your **own account**, but you can also **pay** your bill, get **an email bill**, and eventually once people get signed up, we will be able to send **out notices and notifications** this way. There is also a tab on our website labeled Front Desk where you can access this.

Please notice that service dogs only are allowed in City buildings, per resolution by City Council.

Per City Ordinance- Mowing is required. Any property within the City of Burt, whether vacated or non-vacated, is required to be mowed any time the vegetation reaches a height of more than 8 inches in the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, and October of each year, apart from property used for agricultural purposes.

If you or your children are riding an **electric scooter**, please remind them and yourselves to follow traffic laws, such as stopping at stop signs, and staying on the right side of the road. **Golf carts** should also follow traffic laws. This includes driver's licenses, not riding side by side down roads, as well as drinking and driving. The City appreciates you not driving through all their property (i.e. parks & athletic field) as well, especially when it is wet.
