UTILITY BILL AUTOMATIC BANK WITHDRAWAL: If you are interested in having your utility bill paid directly from your bank account each month, contact City Hall. You will receive your utility bill as usual, but the bank will withdraw the funds from your account on the 15th of the month.

You can **access your own utility account!** Follow these directions to sign up! 1.) Go to: <https://burtiowa.frontdeskqworks.com/> 2.) Create new. 3.) Are you already receiving utility bills from us? **CHOOSE YES.** 4.) Then you will type in the account number and street address. Use the exact street address on your bill. By signing up for **Front Desk** not only will you have access to your own account, but you can also pay your bill, get email billing, and eventually once people get signed up, we will be able to send out notices and notifications this way. There is a tab on our website labeled Front Desk where you can access the link.

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If you're "digging into" your fall projects, be sure to put a call to Iowa One Call on your to-do list. Projects that involve digging-such as erecting a fence, planting a tree, building a deck, etc. - have the potential to create havoc with underground service lines, so call Iowa One Call at 811 or 1-800-292-8989 before you dig- it's the law in Iowa! Iowa one call is a free service that will notify the utilities to come mark the location of any underground lines. Then you'll know where- and where not-to dig. You must call 48 hours in advance of your project, not counting weekends or holidays. (If you call after 5pm, the 48-hour clock will start at 8am the next business day.
